

## **GENERAL COVID GUIDELINES For No Frills 2022**

**REGISTRATION:** There is NO REGISTRATION TABLE at ride camp. ALL documents and PAYMENTS MUST be done online in advance. **NO WALK INS.** Thank you for your cooperation.

**COVID PROTOCOL:** It is the responsibility of the rider/volunteer to ensure that they are healthy before attending No Frills. **Do not attend the ride if you are showing signs** of illness. OR if you have had direct exposure to someone who has tested positive for COVID

**RIDE BRIEFING:** You will receive a hard copy of the ride briefing you your rider packet along with your completion prize. I will have a SHORT Ride Briefing over the PA system in the front field followed by a Q&A. Social distancing will be required.

**NO MEALS WILL BE SERVED:** Please come prepared. Bring your own food/meals and drink, and eat at your own trailers.

**AWAY VET CHECK:** We will still have packaged snacks, Premade PB&J sandwiches, water and Gatorade at the away vet check (self-serve.) For riders and volunteers

**BREAKFAST:** We will provide coffee and prepackaged breakfast **FOR VOLUNTEERS, VET STAFF and Riders.**

**AWARDS CEREMONY/MEETING:** Instead, completion prizes will be in your rider packets and Top Ten and BC will be announced over the PA system in main front field. Winners may pick up their awards at Ride Managers trailer.

**SOCIAL DISTANCING:** Please be considerate of other camp sites and adhere to social distancing standards of AT LEAST 6 feet APART at all times. When visiting other campsites PLEASE consider wearing face covering.

**\*\*\*FACE COVERING or MASKS:** Face covering and/or masks **are RECOMMENDED:** At vet In, when in P&R box, at ALL Vet checks, Finish Line/final vetting, BC presentation, AND anywhere social distancing cannot be observed. Masks will be provided to P&R, scribes, vets, and volunteers. **This may change to REQUIRED if we have another surge in COVID cases in April.**

**VET CARDS:** Riders carry their own vet cards. Please keep it in the Ziplock baggie and handle as little as possible. **PLEASE PROVIDE a self-addressed stamped envelope if you want your ride card returned.**

**VETTING IN:** You will be given a vet in time when you arrive in camp. Please adhere to that time to limit the number of people up at the vet in area. **ONE HORSE + ONE HANDLER!!!!**

**START LINE:** In order to observe Social Distancing Riders **MUST warm up in the field.**

**VET CHECK PROCEDURES:** Remember you WILL BE CARRYING your rider card and procedures are different, so **please read carefully....**

1. As you come off trail: Stop at In Timer Tent. In timer will record your in time and call it out to you. In Timer will run your In time to the P&R table. **DO NOT PULL OUT YOUR CARD YET!!!**
2. **DROP TACK AT THE TOP OF THE HILL IN THE CREW AREA** MAKE SURE YOUR PULSE IS DOWN BEFORE COMING TO P&R BOX.
3. As you approach P&R box (**ONE HANDLER PLEASE**), **call out your rider number** and pull out your card. IN TIME, P&R time and OUT time will be logged on your card at this time
4. Scribe keeps the card and will accompany you to the vet. **P&R will be taken by the vet.**
5. PLEASE observe social distancing while in the vet area. Masks are highly recommended.
6. Riders out time will be radio up to the out timer who will log on a BIG white board for riders to see.
